SUMMER PROGRAMS 2020

Junior Acting 1 & 2

Grades 3-5

Students receive introductory training in acting, voice and movement as they embark on a weeklong acting adventure that focuses on storytelling, improvisation, character creation and collaboration.

Junior Musical Theatre 1 & 2

Grades 3-5

Students will receive introductory training in music, voice, dance and acting through games, workshops, and delving into songs and scenes from their favourite musicals.

Intermediate Musical Theatre

Grades 6-8

Students' acting, voice and dance skills will be challenged and expanded as they work with a music director, choreographer and acting coach through workshops, games, scene studies and exploring the choreography and music of popular musicals.

Intermediate & Senior Acting

Grades 6-12

Focusing on acting training and performance, students will study acting theory, voice work, and movement. Students will also take workshops in various different performance styles such as pantomime, improvisation, puppetry, and physical theatre. These skills will be applied through monologue and scene studies, and original theatre creations led by the students.

Intermediate & Senior Acting for the Camera

Grades 6-12

Students will study advanced classes in film acting, scene study, and the many aspects and roles involved in filmmaking with the award winning filmmakers of Strike Pictures. The professional team at Strike Pictures will lead students through the experience of being directed in a film scene, which will then be edited and screened at the end of the week. Students will then apply what they've learned by creating their own film they will present at the screening.
