Students absent from multiple rehearsals may not be able to participate in the final presentation and may be dismissed from the Theatre School without warning and without a refund.

TNB Theatre School recognizes family, education and performance obligations occur outside of TNB Theatre School programming. Permission for absence may be accommodated at the discretion of the Theatre School Director in the case of exceptional circumstances.
