Theatre New Brunswick Theatre School – Covid19 Operational Plan 2021

Updated December 2021

We've outlined some of the key things to know as you prepare for camp but we encourage you to read our full school policies: www.tnb.nb.ca/policies as well as our COVID-19 Operational Plan.

Arrival and Screening

- o Students and parents will be required to fill out a pre-screening questionnaire before the first class stating that they will be responsible for self-monitoring for COVID-19 symptoms at home. Students displaying symptoms are encouraged to stay home, self monitor, and get tested.
- o Proof of vaccination or proof of exemption is required for all students age 12 and up.
- o Parents/Guardians are not permitted in the building. *Parents/Guardians of Playtime Theatre students will be permitted inside the first week of classes to drop students off. However, parents entering our building must be wearing a mask.
- Community masks are required at all times for all students and instructors when in the building.
- o Students who are asked to stay home from school due to a school exposure are required to stay home from TNB until they are allowed to return to school. Please inform the theatre school director or instructor of your absence.
- O Upon entering the building/studio, students will sanitize and/or wash their hands. Hand sanitizer stations are set up outside the rehearsal hall and the Open Space Theatre.
- Should the Government of New Brunswick require us to close our facility due to COVID-19, classes will switch immediately to online learning and refunds will not be issued.

Pick up

 Students will be picked up outside and supervised by an instructor or teaching assistant. Parents will not be permitted to wait in the lobby/boardroom during classes.

Cleaning schedule

o Cleaning of high touch surfaces will happen before and after each class.
