SUMMER PROGRAMS 2023

Junior Acting

Grades 3-5

Students receive introductory training in acting while embarking on a story creation process that focuses on scene development, character creation, improvisation and collaboration. Through games and exercises, students will work to find characters and stories that will be refined into a final performance.

Junior Musical Theatre 1 & 2

Grades 3-5

Students receive introductory training in dance, acting, and singing through games, exercises, and bringing to life scenes and songs from a well loved musical.

Intermediate & Senior Acting

Grades 6-12

Students study acting theory, movement and voice as well as different forms of performance and storytelling through various workshops. Students will also use scene work and monologues to explore acting technique, voice work, and character development. These scenes and monologues will be shared in a final cabaret style performance.

Intermediate Musical Theatre

Grades 6-8

Students study intermediate acting, dance, and vocal technique as they bring to life scenes and songs from a well loved musical.

Drag Weekend

Grades 9-12

In this two day workshop, students will explore self expression through the art-form of drag. Special guest Annabelle Babineau (aka Barb Wire) will teach students about the origin and evolution of drag and will guide them through the process of crafting their own drag persona. With a healthy dose of glitter and glam, she'll walk them through building a drag character's backstory, finding a performance style, assembling a look, the basics of drag makeup, and finally, how to lip sync for their lives.
